What to know

- Conflict is inevitable.
- It can be an enemy of peace when handled destructively.
- It can be a catalyst to greater peace when handled constructively.
- Handling conflict destructively
 - o Is sinful
 - Causes breach in your relationship with God.
- Expect conflict, but handle it in a peaceful manner

Responses

- Attack (assault, litigation, murder)
- Escape (denial, flight, suicide)
- Peacemaking (overlook, reconciliation, negotiation, mediation, arbitration)

The right attitude

- Conflict is an opportunity
 - To glorify God
 - o To serve Others
 - To grow to be like Christ
- Embrace conflict for the opportunities

Biblical guidelines

- Pursue peace and the building up of one another: Romans 12:18
- Conflict resolution road to travel Matthew 18:15 & Matthew 18:16

How to respond to one who refuses to make peace

- Not one size fits all
- Romans 12:18—If possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone
- Use your moral compass the Holy Spirit
- Don't try to force peace
- Sometimes, it takes time
- Make sure that you are making every effort to pursue peace
